Our students and staff have worked tirelessly throughout the last 2 years to ensure the absolute best outcomes for our students, and this has been rewarded with fantastic results.

## **A-level Results**

Our congratulations go out to our 2024 A-level cohort who celebrated outstanding results this summer with 64.8% of all grades A\* to A and over 85% of grades A\* to B. Over 91% will be heading off to their first-choice university with 88% of students heading to Russell Group and Times Top 10 Universities, and medical or dental schools. We have eleven Oxbridge students. The remainder of our students are heading off to study at international universities, some of the most prestigious art schools or to undertake apprenticeships.

## Chart 2.0a SPC Chart - Results from A-Level qualifications only.




Chart 2.0a shows the value-added scores for A-Level qualifications for Surbiton High School that have been analysed by Alis since 2010. The shaded areas represent confidence limits, the green area a 95% limit and the tan area a 99.7% limit. If a value lies within a shaded area, then the value can be deemed as 'normal' whether it is negative or positive. It is only when the value falls outside the shaded areas that the value can be deemed significant, thus implying that some factor in the teaching and learning, external to the students, has contributed to the value.


# GCSE Valued added by subject
